

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES IN THE ROLLING HILLS ESTATE SUBDIVISION WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the operation of vehicles on the following described roads for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on December 29, 1986, at 2:00 P.M. to take testimony in favor of and in opposition to said regulation; now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED THAT SUBSECTION 10.04.266 is added to the WALLA WALLA COUNTY CODE and reads as follows:

10.04.266 Rolling Hills Estate Subdivision

A) It is unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate the same at a speed in excess of twenty-five miles per hour on any street or road specifically mentioned in the following description:

- 1) Snyder Drive (County Road Log No. 22500) from milepost 0.00 (Bussell Road) to milepost 0.76 (Bussell Road) in Sections 2 and 3, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.,; and,
- 2) Patricia Place (County Road Log No. 22530) from milepost 0.00 (Snyder Drive) to milepost 0.06 (dead end) in Section 2, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.,; and,
- 3) Roland Court (County Road Log No. 22550) from milepost 0.00 (dead end) to milepost 0.04 (Snyder Drive) in Section 3, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.,; and,
- 4) Dale Way (County Road Log No. 22570) from milepost 0.00 (Bussell Road) to milepost 0.10 (Snyder Drive) in Section 2, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M.

B) If any of the provisions of this section are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the section shall not be affected thereby.
