WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the operation of vehicles on all roads within the area described below for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and,


WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on December 29, 1986, at 2:00 P.M. to take public testimony in favor of and in opposition to said regulation; now therefore,


BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that subsection 10.04.320 to the Walla Walla County Code be amended to include the following described area:


