

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE OPERATION OF UNAUTHORIZED MOTOR VEHICLES AND ESTABLISHING A PENALTY THEREFOR UPON THAT PORTION OF WHITMAN DRIVE IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, REDESIGNATED AS A BIKE PATH PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. 88-233.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on April 17, 1989, at the hour of 2:00 p.m., to hear testimony in favor of and in opposition to restricting the operation of motor vehicles and establishing a penalty for said operation on said bike path; now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED that Chapter 10.18 Sections .010, .020 and .030 are hereby added to the WALLA WALLA COUNTY CODE and reads as follows:

#### 10.18.010

Definition - Whitman Drive Bike Path as used in this Chapter means that portion of Whitman Drive described as follows:

A strip of land 60 feet in width situate in the North half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 7 North, Range 35 East, W.M., the centerline of said strip being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in County Road Establishment Number 650A said point being 450 feet Westerly of the East line of Section 32; Thence Westerly and Southwesterly along the centerline of County Road Establishment Numbers 650A, 13 and 281 to the Easterly boundary of the Whitman Mission Donation Claim.

#### 10.18.020

Prohibited Acts - It is unlawful for any unauthorized person to operate or drive any motor vehicle upon the Whitman Drive Bike Path.

#### 10.18.030

Violation, Penalty - Any person violating any terms of this chapter, upon conviction thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

If any of the proposed provisions of this section are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this section shall not be affected thereby.
