

ORDINANCE NO. 203

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF COMPRESSION BRAKES IN AND AROUND THE UNINCORPORATED TOWN OF DIXIE, WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the use of exhaust or jake brakes within the following described area for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 15, 1990, at 2:00 p.m. to take testimony in favor of and in opposition to said regulation; now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, that Section 10.24.020 be amended to include the following:

Also:

All that part of SR 12 situate in Sections 26 and 27, Township 8 North, Range 37 East, W.M. more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the crossing of SR 12 over Dry Creek in said Section 27; Thence, in a northeasterly direction a distance of approximately 1.25 miles to its intersection with Mud Creek Road and the terminus of this description.

Also:

All those parts of Upper Dry Creek Road and Pettybone and Lewiston Roads situate in Section 26, Township 8 North, Range 37 East, W.M. more particularly described as follows:

Upper Dry Creek Road, County Road Log No. 75470 from its intersection with SR 12, at mile post 0.00 southerly for one-half mile to mile post 0.50 and the terminus of this description.

And;

Pettybone Road, County Road Log No. 67950, from its intersection with SR 12, at mile post 0.15; Thence northerly to its intersection with Cemetery Road at mile post 0.30 and the beginning of Lewiston Road, mile post 0.00; Thence continue northerly for one-half mile to mile post 0.50 and the terminus of this description.





WHEREAS, Chapter 10.24 of the Walla Walla County Code can be amended to include the area identified above; now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by this Board of Walla Walla County Commissioners, that a public hearing date of Monday, October 15, 1990, at the hour of 2:00 p.m., be set for hearing said proposed amendment.
