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ORDINANCE NO. 205

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES ON TAUMARSON ROAD IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the operation of vehicles on the following described road for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on February 25, 1991, at 2:00 P.M. to take testimony in favor of and in opposition to said regulation; now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED THAT SUBSECTION 10.04.274 is added to the WALLA WALLA COUNTY CODE and reads as follows:

10.04.274 Taumarsen Road

- A) It is unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate the same at a speed in excess of thirty miles per hour on any street or road specifically mentioned in the following description:

Taumarsen Road (County Road Log Number 51340) from milepost 0.322 to milepost 1.116, at the Old Milton Highway, (County Road Log Number 92570) situate in Section 31, Township 7 North, Range 36 East, W.M.

- B) If any of the proposed provisions of this section are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the section shall not be affected thereby.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the
County Engineer has been ordered to re-
port to the Board of County Commissioners
of Walla Walla County, Washington, on the
proposed vacation of portions of Cargill
Road and Second Street in Section 2,
Township 8 North, Range 30 East, W.M.,
said rights of way proposed to be vacated
being described as follows:

A tract of land situate in the North Half of
the Northeast Quarter of Section 2, Town-
ship 8 North, Range 30 East, W.M., Walla
Walla County, Washington, said tract being
more particularly described as follows:

All those portions of the Inland Empire
Highway, presently known as Second
Street, and County Road Establishment
Number 915, presently known as Cargill
Road, lying northerly and westerly of the
following described line:

East, W.M., said point being 2643.0 feet

Dear Commissioner:

The intent of this Petition is to alert you to a dangerous traffic situation on Taumarson Rd. and to solicit your assistance. We, the undersigned taxpayers and adjacent property owners of Taumarson Rd. have been troubled by vehicles traveling at excessive speeds through our neighborhood. Taumarson Rd. is a very narrow road with no shoulder which passes through a heavily developed residential area. Recent developments (the new mall, Myra St. extension and associate construction, and increased residential development) in the last few years have compounded an already intolerable situation and has resulted in more traffic and speeding.

On November 2, 1990, the State Patrol stopped 6 vehicles within a 15 minute period for speeding; one truck was traveling 57 mph ! This is not some rare isolated situation but an indication of the dangerous ongoing situation we are facing everyday. We walk this street, back our car out of our driveways on to it, and have children that play in the area. Cars have been stopped in excess of 60 mph and we have personally witnessed vehicles traveling at inordinate speeds (over 75 mph). There are a number of measures which you have in your immediate power to alleviate this problem.

We are requesting the following actions be taken immediately:

1. Double stripe Taumarson Rd. from Plaza Way west to a point 100yds beyond Havstad Rd (total distance 1/2 mile). . This will reduce dangerous passing in our neighborhood.
2. Post signs at the east and west end of the area described above indicating: " Residential Area - Children at Play".
3. Post the area for school bus stops.
4. Reduce the speed limit in this residential zone from 35mph to 25mph. This will only increase" thru traffic" travel time through this area by less than 30 seconds, but provide our families the protection they deserve.
5. Provide support to our Sheriff's Office and State Patrol to enforce the speed limit.

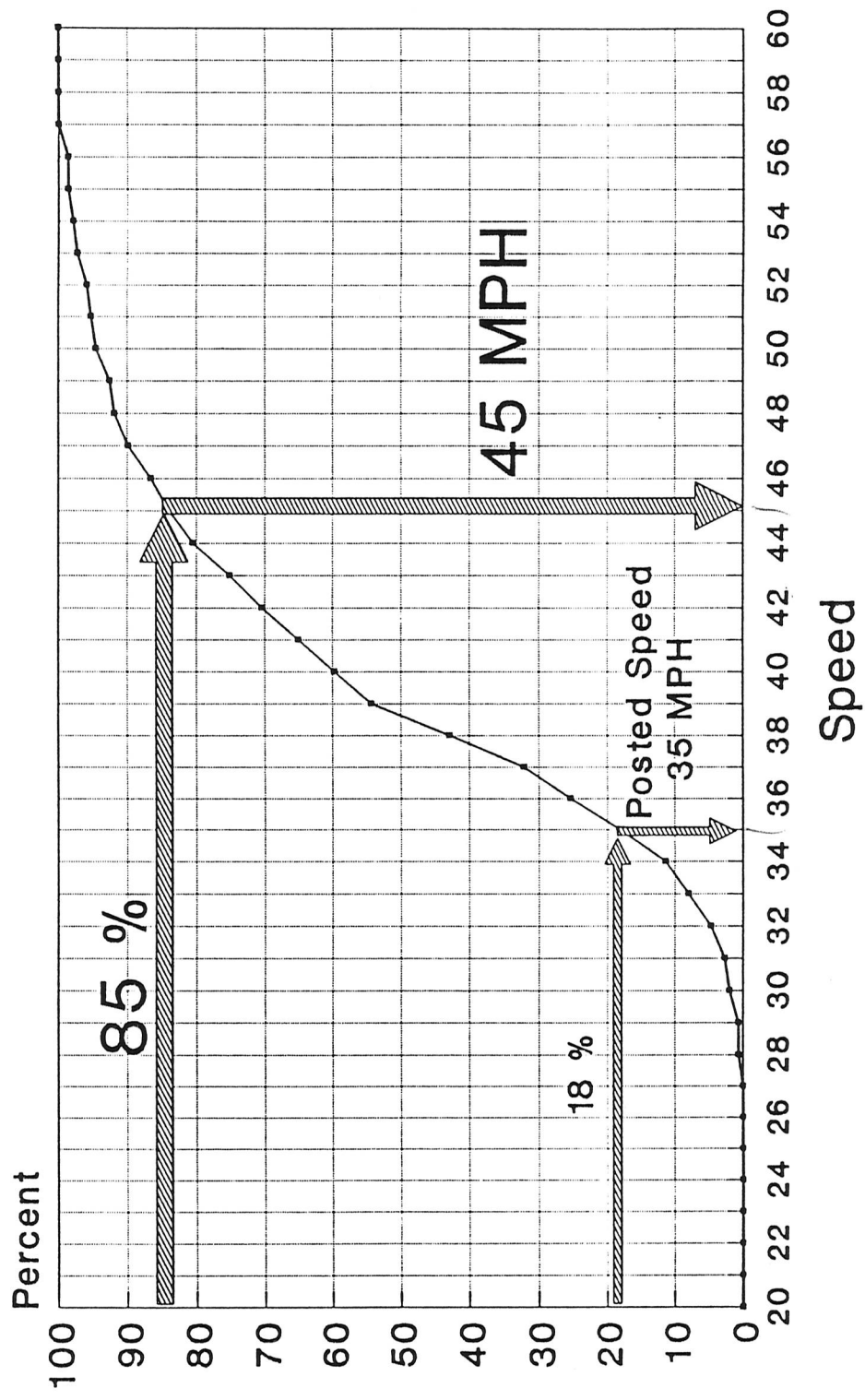
