WHEREAS, American Fine Foods has requested a "Road Variance" from said Code for the seasonal movement of agricultural equipment; now therefore

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by this Board of Walla Walla County Commissioners that they do grant said "Road Variance" request to allow American Fine Foods to transport corn harvesters, on a seasonal basis, over and across the following county roads:

- 1) McDonald Road, between SR 12 and Frog Hollow Road;
- 2) Frog Hollow Road, between McDonald Road and Valley Chapel Road;
- 3) Valley Chapel Road, between Frog Hollow Road and Stateline Road;
- 4) Stateline Road, between Valley Chapel Road and SR 125/Highway 11.

IN REGARDS TO THE ADOPTION OF THE STATE MODEL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO.

WHEREAS, RCW 36.32.120(7) empowers the County to adopt by reference codes that provide for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Walla Walla County, and

WHEREAS, adoption by reference of the Washington Model Traffic Ordinance RCW Chapter 46.90 would provide for the general health, safety and welfare of the members of the public traveling on or using the public roads of Walla Walla County existing outside city limits.

BE IT RESOLVED, that there is hereby added to the Walla Walla County Code of 1985 the following new sections under new Chapter 10.02 which is to read as follows:

Section 10.02.010 - Adoption by Reference

The Washington Model Traffic Ordinance RCW Chapter 46.90 (hereinafter referred to as the "MTO") is adopted by reference as and for the traffic ordinance of this County and as if set forth and full herein,

Section 10.02.020 - Violation Penalty
Any person who is convicted of violating or failing to comply with any of the provisions of this Chapter, shall be punished to receive a penalty as provided for that offense described in the MTO.

Section 10.02.030 - Disposition of Traffic Fines & Forfeitures

All fines or forfeitures collected upon conviction or the forfeiture of bail or the commitment of any of the infracture of any person charged for the violation of any of the provisions of this Chapter, shall be paid into the general fund of the County.

Section 10.02.040 - Official Misconduct

Failure, refusal or neglect on the part of any judicial or another other officer or employee receiving or having custody of any such fine, penalty or forfeiture of bail, either before or after deposited in the general fund to comply with the provisions of Section 10.02.030 shall

constitute misconduct in office and shall be grounds for removal therefrom provided appropriate removal action is taken pursuant to State Law relating to removal of public officials.

Section 10.02.050 - Filing of Ordinance Adopted By This Chapter

Incident to the Adoption of the MTO by reference by this Chapter, copies of the text of the Adopted MTO and of other adopted statutes shall be filed as required by RCW 36.32.120(7) for use and examination by the public.


