

ORDINANCE NO. 212

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 202 - WALLA WALLA COUNTY CODE - CHAPTER 8.32 - PERTAINING TO HEALTH DEPARTMENT ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Walla Walla County Commissioners acting as the Board of Health of Walla Walla County, Washington:

1. Sections 8.32.020 - 8.32.100 are amended as follows and apply to permits and licenses issued for and services rendered on or after January 1, 1993:

8.32.020 Sewage Program Fees. Sewage program fees shall be as follows:

- a) Septic tank permit - New\$ 100.00
- b) Septic tank permit - Replacement of total system or replacement of drainfield or drywell..... \$ 100.00
- c) Septic tank permit - Minor repair or replacement of septic tank only.....\$ 50.00
- d) Septic tank permit - Transfer fee.....\$ 50.00
- e) Septic tank permit - Holding tank or pit privy.....\$ 50.00
- f) Septic tank permit fees will be doubled for any person who fails to obtain a septic tank permit when required.
- g) Sewage system cleaners license - Original.....\$ 75.00/ year
- h) Sewage system cleaners license - Renewal.....\$ 50.00/ year
- i) Sewage system installers license - Original.....\$ 75.00/ year
- j) Sewage system installers license - Renewal.....\$ 50.00/ year

8.32.030 Water Program Fees. Water program fees shall be as follows:

- a) Bacteriological water analysis - In County.....\$ 10.00
- b) Bacteriological water analysis - Out of County.....\$ 15.00
- c) Bacteriological raw water analysis.....\$ 20.00
- d) Chemical water sample shipping & handling.....\$ 5.00
- e) Nitrate water analysis - In County.....\$ 15.00
- f) Nitrate water analysis - Out of County\$ 20.00

8.32.040 Food Program Fees. Food Program fees shall be as follows.

New food permits issued after June 30th for permanent establishments shall be one-half the operating permit fees listed below.

- a) Restaurants - 0-25 Seating Capacity.....\$ 70.00/ year
- 26-50 Seating Capacity.....\$ 80.00/ year
- 51-100 Seating Capacity.....\$ 90.00/ year
- > 100 Seating Capacity.....\$ 100.00/ year
- b) Taverns with food preparation.....\$ 90.00/ year
- c) Taverns without food preparation.....\$ 70.00/ year
- d) Retail meat and fish markets.....\$ 70.00/ year

- e) Grocery store (Basic).....\$ 50.00/year
Add an additional \$ 20.00 for each of the
following departments within a grocery store:
- Meat and/or fish market
 - Food preparation or deli
 - Soup and/or salad bar
 - Bakery
- f) Vending, catering or mobile food unit kitchen.....\$ 90.00/ year
g) Retail bakery - With baking\$ 70.00/ year
h) Retail Bakery - No Baking or Preparation.....\$ 50.00/ year
- i) Concession stand.....\$ 30.00/ year
j) Limited concession.....\$ 20.00/ year
k) Mobile food unit with preparation/cooking of
potentially hazardous foods.....\$ 50.00/ year
l) Mobile food unit without preparation/cooking of
potentially hazardous foods.....\$ 25.00/ year
m) Mobile unit or vending commissary/base without preparation or
cooking of potentially hazardous foods.....\$ 50.00/year
n) Vending machine operation serving potentially
hazardous foods.....\$ 25.00 plus
\$1.00/machine
o) Temporary food service establishment serving
potentially hazardous food.....\$ 15.00 plus
\$5.00/day
p) Temporary food service establishment serving only
non-potentially hazardous food.....\$ 3.00 plus
\$2.00/day
q) New establishment/extensive remodeling review fee (In addition
to the annual operating permit fee).....\$ 50.00
r) Bed & Breakfast Kitchen.....\$ 25.00/ year
s) Jail Kitchen.....\$ 70.00/ year
t) Additional permit fees shall be charged for the following:
- Existing permanent food service establishments
that have not renewed their permit by March 1st
of the renewal year.....\$ 50.00
 - New permanent establishments which operate
without a valid permit\$ 50.00
 - Temporary or seasonal establishments which
operate without a valid permit.....Fee is doubled
- u) Charitable non-profit organizations serving food to the needy are
exempt from paying food service fees.

8.32.050 Solid Waste Program Fees. Solid waste program permit fees shall be as follows:

- a) Sanitary landfill - Initial.....\$ 1000.00
- b) Sanitary landfill - Renewal.....\$ 400.00/ year
- c) Composting sites - Initial.....\$ 300.00
- d) Composting sites - Renewal.....\$ 100.00/ year
- e) Sludge utilization sites - Initial.....\$ 300.00
- f) Sludge utilization sites - Renewal.....\$ 100.00/ year
- g) Other solid waste sites - Initial.....\$ 200.00
- h) Other solid waste sites - Renewal.....\$ 100.00/ year

8.32.060 Loan and/or real estate sewage and/or water evaluations. The fees for sewage and/or water evaluations for loan and/or real estate transactions shall be as follows:

- a) On-site sewage system evaluation only.....\$ 35.00
- b) Domestic water system evaluation only.....\$ 35.00
- c) Sewage and water system evaluation.....\$ 55.00

8.32.070 Plat Review Fees. Plat review fees shall be as follows:

- a) Short plat review.....\$ 50.00

8.32.080 School Inspection Fees. The school inspection fees shall be as follows:

- a) School with cafeteria.....\$ 75.00/ year
- b) School without cafeteria.....\$ 50.00/ year

8.32.090 Swimming Pool Fees. Swimming pool fees shall be as follows:

- a) Limited use pool permit fee.....\$ 50.00/ year
- b) General use pool permit fee.....\$ 100.00/ year

8.32.100 Labor Camp Fees. This section shall be hereby repealed.

- q) New establishment/extensive remodeling review fee (In addition to the annual operating permit fee) 50.00
- r) Bed & Breakfast Kitchen 25.00/year
