WHEREAS, the carrying of firearms except under certain circumstances is now unlawful by virtue of legislation passed by the State of Washington, Laws of 1994, First Extraordinary Session, Chapter 7, section 405(4), amending Title 9.41 of the Revised Code of Washington, effective July 1, 1994; and

WHEREAS, section 405(6) of the same statute permits the County to adopt an ordinance to exempt itself from the prohibition of section 405(4); and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on July 18, 1994, to hear testimony in favor of or in opposition to the adoption of the aforementioned ordinance; now therefore

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by this Board of Walla Walla County Commissioners that they deem it in the best interest of the public to adopt an ordinance exempting Walla Walla County from the prohibition of subsection (4) of section 405 of Laws of 1994, First Extraordinary Session, Chapter 7, as enacted and herein amended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said ordinance shall be effective immediately.
