## ORDINANCE NO. 255

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE COUNTY ENGINEER TO REGULATE SPEEDS ON ALL COUNTY ROADS FOR SPECIAL CONDITIONS AND FOR REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON TWO RIVERS ROAD IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON:

WHEREAS, there is a need to allow for the regulation of motor vehicles on all county roads under special conditions for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, there is a need to regulate the operation of vehicles on the following described road for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 25, 1999, at 2:00 p.m., to take testimony in favor of and/or in opposition to said regulation; now therefore,

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED,** by this Board of Walla Walla County Commissioners, that Subsections 10.04.001 and 10.04.021 be added to the Walla Walla County Code which shall contain the following:

## 10.04.001 General Provisions.

A. Title. This chapter shall be known as "Walla Walla County Speed Limits" and may be cited as such.

B. Applicability. This chapter shall apply within the unincorporated area of Walla Walla County.

- <u>C. Authority.</u> i.) RCW 46.61.415 allows local authorities, in their respective jurisdictions, to determine on the basis of an engineering study and traffic investigation, that the maximum speed permitted under RCW 46.61.400 or RCW 46.61.440 is greater or less than is reasonable or safe for conditions found to exist upon a road or part of a road.
- ii) The Board of County Commissioners, based on the findings of the County Engineer's engineering study and traffic investigation, will determine whether or not to change the maximum speed limits on certain county roads.
- iii) The County Engineer is hereby granted the authority to change the speed limit by 10 miles per hour or more, on any county road when there are special conditions such as in construction/maintenance areas, areas in which authorized persons are working within or adjacent the traveled roadway, or to further protect the public health, safety and welfare. Said changed speed limit shall become effective and enforceable upon the erection of the appropriate signs.

## 10.04.021 Two Rivers Road

It is unlawful for the operator of any motor vehicle to operate the A. same at a speed in excess of twenty miles per hour on any street or road specifically mentioned in the following description:

Two Rivers Road (County Road Log No. 13100) from SR 12 (MP 0.00) to the end of the County Road at MP 0.36, situate in Section 28, Township 8 North, Range 31 East, W.M.

B. If any of the proposed provisions of these sections are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the section shall not be affected thereby.
