ORDINANCE NO. 261

WHEREAS, application has been made by Columbia REA for a zoning code text amendment for a public utility service center to be in a FR zone, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on March 7, 2001 to consider the request and recommends to the Board of County Commissioners that the Zoning Code Text Amendment be approved based on the following findings and conditions:

### Findings:

- 1. The amendment is of public necessity. Under the List of Uses in Walla Walla County Code 17.16.010, public utility service and storage yards are only allowed in Heavy Industrial and Light Industrial zones. Light and Heavy areas are in limited supply in Walla Walla county and these areas are needed for facilities that require such zoning, this puts undue hardship on Public Utilities when trying to find a location for public utility service and storage yards.
- 2. The amendment benefits the general welfare of the County. Allowing public utilities service and storage yards in the FR zone would allow utility companies to better service customers. Service provided by Public Utilities will greatly improve due to increased response time during emergencies.
- 3. The amendment constitutes good planning and zoning practices because the activities that take place in a public utility service and storage yard are not activities that necessitate a Light or Heavy Industrial classification. The large lot setting of the FR zone does constitute an appropriate setting for public utility service and storage yards because no lot can be created any smaller than one acre in size, which allows for greater separation from surrounding property owners.
- 4. The Environmental Review Committee has issued a Determination of Non-Significance on the proposal.

  - A. No office space open to the public will be allowed.

  - D. The site perimeter will be landscaped and fenced with screening.
  - E. Other mitigating matters may apply.

WHEREAS, application has been made by Columbia REA for a zoning code text amendment for a public utility service center to be in a FR zone, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on March 7, 2001 to consider the request and recommends to the Board of County Commissioners that the Zoning Code Text Amendment be approved based on the following findings and conditions:

#### Findings:

- 1. The amendment is of public necessity. Under the List of Uses in Walla Walla County Code 17.16.010, public utility service and storage yards are only allowed in Heavy Industrial and Light Industrial zones. Light and Heavy areas are in limited supply in Walla Walla county and these areas are needed for facilities that require such zoning, this puts undue hardship on Public Utilities when trying to find a location for public utility service and storage yards.
- 2. The amendment benefits the general welfare of the County. Allowing public utilities service and storage yards in the FR zone would allow utility companies to better service customers. Service provided by Public Utilities will greatly improve due to increased response time during emergencies.
- 3. The amendment constitutes good planning and zoning practices because the activities that take place in a public utility service and storage yard are not activities that necessitate a Light or Heavy Industrial classification.
