ORDINANCE NO. 265

WHEREAS, application has been made by Doug Lundgren for a rezone from AG, LI to CG-L, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on July 11, 2001 to consider the request and recommends to the Board of County Commissioners that the Rezone be approved based on the following findings:

Findings:

- A. Although the property in question has a comprehensive plan of Unclassified, the 2001 Comprehensive Plan lays the groundwork for the rezone. The new land use designation of Agricultural/Light Industrial outlines allowances for certain commercial uses not otherwise allowed in either Agricultural or Light Industrial designations.
- B. The proposed rezone would not be detrimental to the public health, welfare and/or good planning, and zoning practices. Proper mitigating measures were addressed through a traffic study and with the adoption of the new comprehensive plan.
- C. Changes have occurred since the adoption of the zoning in this area with the introduction of more light industrial zones to the area. A convenience store would be an appropriate support service for the area.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners reviewed the public record on August 21, 2001;

Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by this Board of Walla Walla County Commissioners that they approve the Rezone for Doug Lundgren, Docket Number PC-00-16 based on the findings above.
