ORDINANCE NO. 314

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.04 OF THE WALLA WALLA COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO FOOD SERVICE SANITATION, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION BY REFERENCE OF THE WASHINGTON STATE BOARD OF HEALTH RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO STANDARDS FOR FOOD SERVICE AS THE SAME MAY NOW EXIST OR HEREAFTER BE AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Walla Walla County Commissioners acting as the Board of Health of Walla Walla County, Washington:

- 1. Section 8.04.040 of the Walla Walla County Code is amended to read as follows:
 - 8.04.040 Adoption by reference. The Washington State Board of Health Rules & Regulations for Food Service Standards (Chapter 246-215, WAC) adopted September 8, 2004, are hereby adopted by reference as the food service standards for Walla Walla County. All amendments and additions to the Washington State Board of Health, when printed and filed with the county auditor shall become amendments and additions to this chapter.
- 2. Section 8.04.050 of the Walla Walla County Code is repealed.
- 3. New Section 8.04.050 is added to read as follows:
 - 8.04.050 Violation - Penalty. Anyone violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this article shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine of not more than three hundred dollars or to imprisonment of not more than ninety days or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day a violation of this article continues shall be considered a separate offense.
- 4. Section 8.04.060 of the Walla Walla County Code is repealed.
- 5. New Section 8.04.060 is added to read as follows:
 - <u>8.04.060</u> Severability. Should any part of this article be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this article.
- 6. Section 8.04.070 of the Walla Walla County Code is repealed.
- 7. This ordinance shall be effective May 2, 2005.
