ORDINANCE NO. 337

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY NECESSARY FOR THE NORTH EXTENSION OF MYRA ROAD, DECLARING THE PUBLIC USE AND NECESSITY OF SAME, AND AUTHORIZING THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY TO BEGIN **CONDEMNATION PROCEEDINGS**

WHEREAS, the need for the Myra Road North Extension project has been recognized for more than 40 years; and

WHEREAS, the cities of College Place and Walla Walla and Walla Walla County have worked cooperatively to acquire, design and plan the extension of Myra Road; and

WHEREAS, by interlocal agreement, Walla Walla County has been designated as the lead agency for the project's design, planning, construction and right of way acquisition; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence; and

WHEREAS, the route of the Myra Road extension was held in private ownership by numerous parties; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to acquire property in a fair manner, ensuring that property owners are fairly compensated for right of way acquisition; and

WHEREAS, condemnation proceeding will assure that the property owners are fairly compensated for their properties; and

WHEREAS, the County must balance the interests of the property owners against the need to control cost by moving forward with the project in a timely fashion; and

WHEREAS, a report has been received from the County Engineer, detailing steps which have been taken to acquire the necessary properties; and

WHEREAS, a properly advertised public hearing regarding the acquisition of certain property to be utilized in the extension of Myra Road was held on January 2, 2007;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. The north extension of Myra Road will strengthen the infrastructure of the communities of the City of Walla Walla, the City of College Place and Walla Walla County.
- 2. The route and plans, as displayed on Exhibit A, for the north extension of Myra Road are appropriate, and have been endorsed by the Cities of College Place and Walla Walla and Walla Walla County.
- 3. The north extension of Myra Road will relieve congestion and provide a necessary bypass route to facilitate travel between U.S. Highway 12 and Highway 125.
- 4. The properties listed on Exhibit B are appropriate and necessary to be acquired for right of way purposes for the north extension of Myra Road.
- 5. Walla Walla County has engaged in good faith negotiations with property owners to purchase property without resorting to condemnation.

THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners makes the following conclusions of law:

- 1. The acquisition of the properties listed on Exhibit B is for public use and necessity.
- 2. The County is authorized by its Interlocal Agreements and RCW 8.08, RCW 36.70.040, RCW 36.89.030 and RCW 47.52.050 to acquire the properties listed on Exhibit B for condemnation.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDAINED, by this Board of Walla Walla County Commissioners, that the acquisition of the properties listed on Exhibit B is for public use and necessity, and the Prosecuting Attorney is authorized to begin condemnation proceedings in accordance with RCW 8.08. Nothing in this ordinance precludes the County, through the Prosecuting Attorney, from continuing to negotiate with property owners pending Superior Court proceedings.


