A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON \_\_East Isaacs Avenue IN WALLA WALLA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WALLA WALLA COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

Section 1 In order to make this Resolution, relating to the operation of motor vehicles, on a certain County Road, known as \_\_ East Isaacs Avenue , in Walla Walla County, Washington, uniform with the provisions of the Washington Motor Vehicle Act (Being Chapter 309 of the Laws of Washington for the year 1927) as amended or as hereafter may be amended; all of the provisions of the Washington Highway License Act (Being Chapter 189 of the Laws of Washington for the year 1937) as amended or as they may hereafter be amended; and all of the provisions of the Washington State Highway Act (Being Chapter 53 of the Laws of Washington for the year 1937) as amended or as they hereafter may be amended; are hereby adopted by the County of Walla Walla and are by reference made a part of this resolution.

Section 2 Any person violating any terms of the laws referred to in Section 1 of this Resolution within the bounds to be hereafter mentioned shall be guilty of a violation of this Resolution.

Section 3 It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate the same at a speed in excess of the following: Thirty Five (35) miles per hour on any street or road specifically mentioned in the following description or any speed posted by the County Engineer on any street or road in the following description:

East Isaacs Avenue, from Link Street, Easterly to S.R. 12, a distance of 1.68 miles. (County Road Log No. 97330, milepost 2.87 to milepost 4.34; and County Road Log No. 63100, milepost 0.00 to milepost 0.21) Located in Sections 13, 14, 15, and 22, of Township 7 North, Range 36 E.W.M.

Section 4 Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Resolution, or who shall counsel, aid, or abet any such violation or fail to comply shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding \$ 100.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5 If any of the proposed provisions of this Resolution are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the Resolution shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6 This Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and shall be in effect immediately upon its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 137

WHEREAS, damage to certain county roads is being done by winter recreational use or other use by certain members of the public, and

WHEREAS, said roads are not major thoroughfares whose use is generally required by the motoring public, and

WHEREAS, said roads are in a condition because of wet weather to be damaged by said use, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing will be held concerning the within Ordinance following public notice in the official newspaper

for Walla Walla County, and WHEREAS, R.C.W. Chapter 47.48 permits this Board to close county roads, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

by this Board.

Section 1.

THAT, after certification by the Board of County Com-missioners of Walla Walla County, specific sections of specific county roads shall be closed to all vehicular traffic for specific time lengths and except for required travel by emergency vehicles or school buses and, after notice has been published describing said road and after each end of the road closed is posted: IT SHALL UNLAWFUL for anyone to operate any motor vehicle on said certified sections of roads. Section 2.

Any person who violates the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force seven days from and after its passage.
