Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Walla Walla County, Washington, will hold a public hearing at 11:00 a.m. on Monday, November 3, 2014 in Commissioners' Chambers, Walla Walla County Public Health and Legislative Building, 314 West Main, Walla Walla, Washington to receive public testimony regarding a proposed amendment to Walla Walla County (Zoning) Code regarding recreational marijuana uses, as follows.
17.16.010 Establishment of uses.
The use of a property is defined by the activity for which the building or lot is intended, designed, arranged, occupied or maintained. All applicable requirements of this code, or other applicable state or federal requirements, shall govern a use located in unincorporated Walla Walla County. Any recreational marijuana land use including, but not limited to, production, processing, storage, and retail sale of recreational marijuana and marijuana-derived products are prohibited land uses in unincorporated Walla Walla County.
