The use of a property is defined by the activity for which the building or lot is intended, designed, arranged, occupied or maintained. All applicable requirements of this code, or other applicable state or federal requirements, shall govern a use located in unincorporated Walla Walla County. Any recreational marijuana land use including, but not limited to, production, processing, storage, and retail sale of recreational marijuana and marijuana-derived products are prohibited land uses in unincorporated Walla Walla County.
