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TEMPORARY RETAIL FIREWORKS STAND POLICY

State Fireworks Law, Chapter 70.77 RCW
Walla Walla County Code 15.04.140

The following described process must be completed by the first week of June to allow the Department adequate time to approve all retail fireworks stands. A separate application is necessary for each stand, as the license is only valid for one stand.

Secure a license application form from the Office of the State Fire Marshal. You can download the Application for Retail Fireworks License (www.wsp.wa.gov/fire/fwretail.htm) or you can contact the office at (360) 596-3916 to request the form be sent to you. The state requires that the application be filed no later than May 1 of the year fireworks are to be sold to be applicable for the July holiday season. To be applicable for the New Year's celebration, the application must be filed no later than November 1.

Send a copy of your state Fireworks Stand License and Certificate of Insurance to Walla Walla County Community Development Department, at the above address, along with your completed Walla Walla County Temporary Retail Fireworks Stand Permit Application and the application fee of \$100.00, payable to Walla Walla County

The proposed retail fireworks stand application will be reviewed by the County Building Official/Fire Marshal. Upon approval, a Fireworks Stand Permit will be returned to the applicant validated by the County Fire Marshal. The Fireworks Stand Permit must be conspicuously displayed at all times while the stand is open to the public. The County Building Inspector will perform an initial inspection prior to the stand being open for business. If you have any questions, please call the WWCCDD at (509) 524-2610.
