Mitigation Measures:

Background: The Washington State Department of Archaeology & Historic Preservation (DAHP)
responded during the comment period on the Notice of Application that an inadvertent
discovery plan (IDP) should be prepared prior to any ground disturbance because the area has
never been surveyed and there is a high potential for subsurface deposits being present on the
parcel, including ancestral remains.

Mitigate Measure: Prior to any ground disturbance, the applicant shall coordinate with DAHP to prepare an IDP that meets the requirements.
