Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 1:30 PM (or as close thereto as possible) on Monday, June 17, 2019, in Commissioners' Chambers, Walla Walla County Public Health and Legislative Building, 314 West Main, Walla Walla, Washington to receive public testimony and consider the following amendment proposal.

1. ZCA19-002 – Walla Walla County Land Use Fee Update

Walla Walla County has not increased land development fees since 2007 and the current fees do not compensate the County for all its costs of processing land use planning applications and preparing detailed reports and statements required by County code and State law. RCW 26.32.120 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to establish a fee schedule. The proposed amendment would increase the land use application fees established in Walla Walla County Code (WWCC) Chapter 3.08 for the purpose of recovering some portion of the processing cost of zoning, platting, and other land use and development related permit applications.

Written comments regarding these amendments may be submitted prior to and at the hearing on June 17. This is the final opportunity to comment; written comments cannot be accepted after the public hearing is closed on June 17.
