Intent – Decision

Topic - Approval of Bid award for the installation of security transaction windows, walls and door for the County Clerk's office located at 315 West Main adjacent to the Courthouse.

Summary

Walla Walla County Facilities Maintenance Department requested bids for a project identified as the WALLA WALLA COUNTY CLERK'S SECURITY WINDOWS PROJECT, utilizing the limited public works procedures (Resolution 11-115) for the installation of security transaction windows, walls and door for the County Clerk's office. In the bid documents we requested bids for two options: Option A to include bullet resistant walls and windows (as described in the bid documents), and Option B to include attack resistant windows and standard walls (as described in the bid documents). The following bids were received timely for the project:

Opp & Seibold General Construction, Inc. 1220 West Poplar Walla Walla, WA 99362

Option A \$66,262.28

Option B \$47,214.62

The bids include all state electrical permits, materials, labor, and Washington State sales tax.

Cost

As the intent of the project is to increase security in the County Clerk's office, the recommendation is to select and proceed with the Option A bid. Total cost including tax, permits, prevailing wage and all materials as listed in the scope of work is \$66,262.28 for Option A.

Scope of Work

Scope of work is as outlined in the RFQ documents, a copy of which is attached.

Project Time Schedule

The contractor will have two full working days, tentatively set for Thursday & Friday December 17th & 18th, to complete the majority of the three walls. This is scheduled with the information that all materials will be delivered and available at these dates. Project must be completed prior to December 30th, 2015.

Conclusion/Recommendation

Recommend that the Board of County Commissioners approve awarding the bid for the County Clerk's office project referenced above to Opp & Seibold for Option A, in the amount of \$66,262.28.

Replace the existing timber bridge with a prefabricated timber laminated superstructure resting on new abutments and widen road to meet current standards.
