As corrected on February 1, 2016

<u>2016 SALARIES FOR WALLA WALLA COUNTY EMPLOYEES WHO ARE REPRESENTED BY A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UNIT (effective January 1, 2016)</u>

- Under the Current Expense Courthouse agreement, the schedule for 2016 wages shall reflect an increase equal of 1.5%. (80% of the June 2015 measure of the CPI-U (Seattle-Bremerton) of 1.6% equals 1.28%; the agreement provides that the minimum CPI-U adjustment shall be limited to 1.5%. Thus for 2016 the members of Current Expense Courthouse union will receive the minimum 1.5% cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) as provided.)
- For employees covered by the Road Crew Local 1191, (the "Public Works Contract") the COLA shall reflect a 1.28% increase, as required by Article 17 of their Contract. (June, 2015 measurement was 1.6%; eighty percent of that figure is 1.28%.)
- Members of the Commissioned Deputies unit shall receive, pursuant to their 2016 agreement and the approved corrected Appendix A 2016 Salary Schedule, a 2.25% increase to 2015 salaries.
- Members of the Walla Walla Sheriff's Corrections and Professionals Association, which bargaining unit's contract ended on December 31, 2015 and which contract has not been agreed to for 2016, will remain frozen at the 2015 wage schedule rates.

2016 SALARIES FOR CERTAIN APPOINTED WALLA WALLA COUNTY EMPLOYEES WHO ARE NOT REPRESENTED (effective January 1, 2016)

Effective January 1, 2016 the compensation schedule for the following non-represented and/or named appointed positions shall be increased by one and five tenths percent (1.5%), consistent with the Current Expense Courthouse agreement now in place, and based on an employee's respective salary in effect as of December 31, 2015:

- <u>All non-represented employees</u> (those not covered by a collective bargaining agreement, to include those in the Public Works Department) shall receive the same 1.5% COLA as outlined above.
- <u>chief deputies appointed by county elected officials</u> (deputies appointed by the County Assessor, County Auditor, County Clerk, Board of County Commissioners, and County Treasurer, pursuant to RCW 36.16.070)
- <u>administrative</u>, exempt (unclassified under Civil Service) employees appointed by the county <u>sheriff</u>, pursuant to and authorized by RCW 41.14.070
- the chief deputy prosecuting attorney
- <u>certain employees who have entered into separate Employment Agreements with Walla Walla County</u> (Mike Bates, Tom Byers, Harvey Crowder, Sheila Eslinger, Randy Glaeser, Tom Glover, Kevin Gutierrez, Liz Jessee, and Heather Lee)
