Background:

We have been working on preparing fee updates for all of our Building and Planning Fees. The last time land use application fees were updated was 2019. At that time the Department worked with the Commissioners to develop an approach that could be used to more regularly update fees. Prior to 2019, land use fees had not been updated since 2007. During the 2019 review, actual costs to process each application type was estimated. Ultimately fees that were adopted were 50% of the actual costs, although in some cases where there was not a big difference between the existing fee and the actual cost, the actual cost was adopted.

I have updated the overhead costs and staff costs spread sheets based on the adopted 2022 budget. Overall, costs have increased since 2019 by approximately 25%. In Attachment 3, I calculated the approximate current cost for each permit type so it can be compared to the current fee. In most cases there is a substantial difference.

I have incorporated building staff into Schedule A and B so that this can be used to update Building Permit fees as well, assuming that we would utilize the same approach to estimating costs.

I'm providing background documents and calculations on planning fees for this workshop, with the goal of getting general feedback and then presenting building/fire fees at another workshop within a couple of weeks.

Policy Questions

- 1. Should fees be updated at this time to cover the actual cost?
- 2. If we do not increase to actual cost, do we include automatic ramping to reach the actual cost within 2 or 3 years? Or longer period?
- 3. One of the biggest (and most varying) cost for land use application is the cost for Hearing Examiner Services. Should we charge applicants for the actual cost?
- 4. Should we charge for Preapplication and other Technical Review Committee meetings? Is the first one free, but not the second?
- 5. Should we include a hold/delay fee? Charge applicant a fee to restart their application review if it's been on hold for more than 6 months? Or just include a sunset provision? Application expires if no movement in 4 or 6 months? Planning Commission recommended 120 days.
- 6. Second Review Fees Should we charge applicant if after one review cycle their application does not meet standards? This should be applied for land use and building permits?
- 7. Are there costs missing in overhead/salary spreadsheets? What about Code Enforcement?
