- EMT class is on for Fall, 16 students. There are scholarships available.

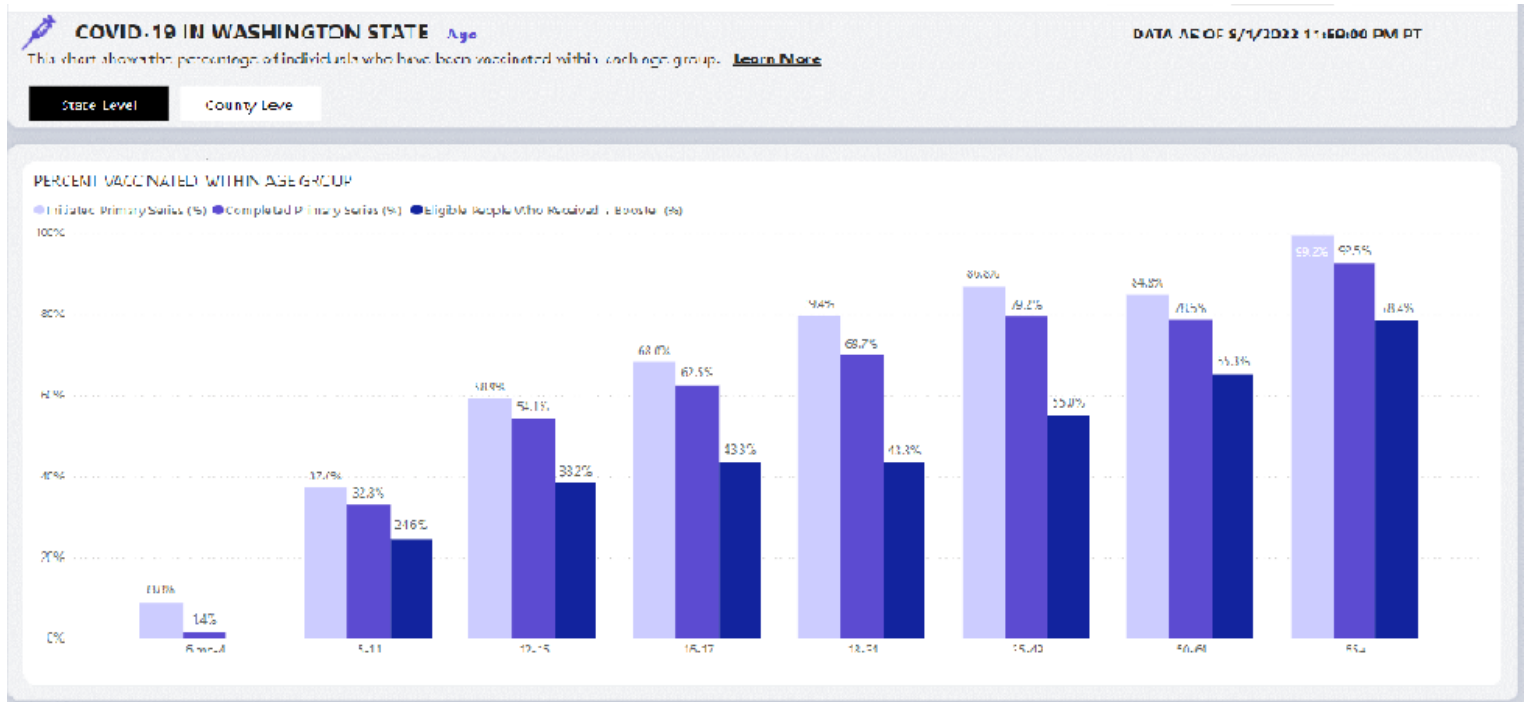
**TRAFFIC SAFETY:**
