Trash and Recycling collection

Trash and Recycling will only be collected in Town approved containers. Leaves and grass clippings in paper bags will be picked up on trash day and should not be put out on street until trash day. (10 bag limitcurbside)

Additional recycling and residential yard waste may be dropped off at the Transfer Station, 21 Birch Swamp Road, Warren at no cost.

Transfer Station Rules and Information

Hours of Operation

Monday-Friday 7:30 to 11:45 a.m. and 12:30 to 3:30 p.m. Saturdays* 7:30 a.m. until 11:45 a.m. *The facility is closed on July 4, 2024 and on Saturdays in the month of February. Disposal Rates

Residential Household trash disposal rate	\$235 per ton
Residential Yard Waste (dropped at transfer station)	
Commercial trash disposal rate	\$300 per ton
Commercial yard waste, brush disposal rate	\$85 per ton
Refrigerator, air conditioner, dehumidifier disposal rate dropped at transfer station	\$25 each item
Refrigerator, air conditioner, dehumidifier disposal rate at the curbside	\$35 each item
Mattress, Box spring, dropped at transfer station	No Charge
Mattress, Box spring, Metal household appliances (without freon), Couches, Entertainment centers for pick up	\$20 each item
Television, computer monitor, other small household appliances (without freon), dropped at transfer station	No Charge
Television, computer monitor, other small household appliances (without freon), for pick up	\$15 each item
Computer & Electronic waste dropped at transfer station (Pick up not available)	No Charge
Car Tire disposal dropped at transfer station (see website for other tire sizes and prices)	\$7.50 each item

Resident Sticker

\$20.00 per Household for trash or yard waste. Metal is free of charge with residential sticker. Transfer station passes are also valid for access to the Warren Town Beach.

Residents with a sticker will be charged at the residential rate. Commercial vehicles or dump trucks over 10,000 lbs GVW are prohibited from obtaining a resident sticker.

Attendant will inspect each load prior to dumping.

Please note that a fee will be charged as indicated above for refrigerator, tire, air conditioner and dehumidifier.

- **Loads** must be sorted for proper disposal, ie: trash, construction debris, metals, brush, yard waste, tires, television, computers, wood, etc. (Wood must be no longer than 4 feet in length.)
- By law, this facility cannot accept any hazardous waste. This includes but is not limited to paints, thinners, pesticides, gasoline or any product with CAUTION or WARNING on its label.
- Waste oil, old oil filters, used antifreeze, may be disposed of in the designated areas free of charge to residents.
- Household hazardous waste can be disposed of in Warren by calling 401.942.1430 ext 241 Rhode Island Resource Recovery Corporation (RIRRC).

Wood Chipping Program

Piles for chipping must be no higher than 3 feet and no wider than 4 feet. Nothing larger than 4 inches around will be accepted. No logs or stumps will be accepted. No landscaper generated piles will be accepted. Please call the DPW at 401.245.0200 to be placed on the chipping list.

Frequently Asked Questions RECYCLING

What goes in the recycling cart? Paper, glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, tin cans, plastic bottles and jars.

What should <u>NOT</u> go in the recycle cart? No plastic bags, no hazardous materials, no containers of hazardous material, no household trash, no yard waste, no construction material, no styrofoam peanuts.

Can I get an extra recycling cart? Yes, Call the DPW at 245-0200

TRASH

What if I have my own barrel? The Town will only collect material in the container provided. Extra trash can be brought to the transfer station at 21 Birch Swamp Road. No trash will be collected outside of the container.

Can I get an extra trash cart? No.
