

LEGAL NOTICE

November 8, 2022 State Election

The Electors of the Town of Watertown are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in said town on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the following purposes:

- I. To cast their votes for Governor and Lieutenant Governor, United States Senator, Representative in Congress, State Senator, State Representative, Secretary of the State, Treasurer, Comptroller, Attorney General, Judge of Probate, and Registrar of Voters.
- II. To vote on the following question for the approval or disapproval of a proposed AMENDMENT to the Constitution of Connecticut, a vote of “YES” being a vote for approval, and a vote of “NO” being a vote for disapproval:

1. Shall the Constitution of the State be amended to permit the General Assembly to provide for early voting?

The full text of such proposed questions with explanatory text, printed in accordance with §2-30a of the General Statutes, is available at the Town Clerk’s office for public distribution.

The vote on the proposed questions is taken pursuant to the Constitution of Connecticut.

- III. To vote on the following local questions for approval or disapproval of ordinances adopted by the Town Council on September 6, 2022 and entitled: “An Ordinance Appropriating \$1,500,000 For The Acquisition of a Fire Truck and Related Equipment; And Authorizing The Issue of Bonds Or Notes And Temporary Notes In The Same Amount To Finance The Appropriation,” “An Ordinance Appropriating \$5,000,000 For Various Road Improvements and Related Work; And Authorizing The Issue Of Bonds Or Notes And Temporary Notes In The Same Amount To Finance The Appropriation” And “An Ordinance Appropriating \$12,861,000 For Various School Capital Improvements And Authorizing The Issue Of Bonds Or Notes And Temporary Notes In The Same Amount To Finance The Appropriation.” The full texts of the ordinances were published in the Town Times newspaper on September 15, 2022, and are on file in the office of the Town Clerk and available for public inspection during normal business hours.

The ordinances will be placed on the ballot under the following headings:

2. “SHALL THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN APPROPRIATE \$1,500,000 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A FIRE TRUCK AND RELATED EQUIPMENT; AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS OR NOTES AND TEMPORARY NOTES IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION?”

3. “SHALL THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN APPROPRIATE \$5,000,000 FOR VARIOUS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS AND RELATED WORK; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF BONDS OR NOTES AND TEMPORARY NOTES IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION?”

4. “SHALL THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN APPROPRIATE \$12,861,000 FOR VARIOUS SCHOOL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS; AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS OR NOTES AND TEMPORARY NOTES IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION?”

The vote on the above questions will be taken under the authority of Section 709 of the Town Charter and Section 9-369 of the Connecticut General Statutes. Electors approving an ordinance will vote “Yes” and those opposing said ordinance will vote “No”. Absentee ballots may be obtained from the Town Clerk’s office, and will be centrally counted at Watertown Town Hall, 61 Echo Lake Rd., Watertown, CT 06795.

Voting tabulators will be used. The polls will be opened at six o'clock in the morning (6:00 a.m.) and will remain open until eight o'clock in the evening (8:00 p.m.).
