The Board of Supervisors met in Session on the above date with the following members present: Leffler, Campbell, Dencklau, Carlson and Thode. Absent: None.

Moved by Dencklau, seconded by Leffler to approve the agenda with item #8 (*Hiring and employment of Aubrey Brown, Corrections Officer, effective April 4, 2018 at the rate of \$15.54 per hour, per recommendation of Steve Elifrits, Jails Administrator*) removed. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Carlson to approve March 27, 2018 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Carlson, seconded by Thode to approve the following Drainage Claims: DD#5, Roland Township, Section 12; DD #117 Dayton Township, Section 23. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Thode, seconded by Dencklau to accept and place on file the hiring and employment of Paige Workman, Clerk – Recorder's Office, effective Monday, April 9, 2018 at the rate of \$13.53 per hour, per recommendation of Lindsay Laufersweiler, Webster County Recorder. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Dencklau, seconded by Leffler to accept and place on file the resignation of Amanda Pigman, Typist Advanced, Child Support Recovery Unit, effective April 5, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Carlson to accept and place on file the hiring and employment of Aubrey Brown, Corrections Officer, effective April 4, 2018 at the rate of \$15.54 per hour, per recommendation of Steve Elifrits, Jails Administrator. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Carlson, seconded by Thode to accept and place on file the employment title change of Shawna Dencklau from Corrections Officer-Sergeant to Assistant Jail Administrator, effective April 4, 2018 to coincide with current job responsibilities. Hourly rate of pay remains the same. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Thode, seconded by Dencklau to receive and place on file FY 18 3rd quarter Veteran Affairs Person's Served Report. Motion carried unanimously.

A Public Hearing was held on the second consideration to repeal General Assistance Ordinance No. 043 and Amendment No.1 in its entirety and replace with General Assistance Ordinance No. 053 an ordinance to describe the forms of assistance provided by Webster County, in accordance with Chapter 252, to poor persons and needy persons. The ordinance establishes criteria which must be met by an applicant before assistance is made available to persons in any of the two categories. No written or oral comments were received. Hearing was closed by Chairman Campbell.

Moved by Dencklau, seconded by Leffler to approve second consideration and waiving third consideration to repeal General Assistance Ordinance No. 043 and Amendment No. 1 in its entirety and replace with the following: **(Type Out)** Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Carlson to approve and authorize Chair to sign permit from Asplundh Tree Expert Company, Council Bluffs, Iowa, to remove trees from under and around overhead electric lines owned by MidAmerican Energy at various locations throughout the county. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Carlson, seconded by Thode to approve and authorize Chair to sign permit from MidAmerican Energy to extend permanent electric service to two duplexes at 2409 & 2411 240th Street and 2413 & 2415 240th Street in Section 9, Township 88 North, Range 28 West, Pleasant Valley Township. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Thode, seconded by Dencklau to receive and place on file 12 month pay increase to \$22.23 per hour for Mark Lara, Class B Equipment Operator, effective April 4, 2018 and payroll dated April 13, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Dencklau, seconded by Leffler to approve and authorize Chair to sign Iowa Department of Transportation Federal Aid Agreement No. 1-18-HBP-S-004 for County Highway Bridge Program Funding on Project BRS-CO94(113)--60-94 on D18 over Brushy Creek between Sections 16 and 21, Township 89 North, Range 27 West, Colfax Township.
