The Board of Supervisors met in Session on the above date with the following members present: Leffler, Campbell, Dencklau, Carlson and Thode. Absent: None.

The Board of Supervisors met to hold a workshop on the proposed ATV Ordinance 052.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mark Campbell.

No new written comments were received. Chairman Campbell opened the meeting for public comments. Beverly Mericle, Rich George and Jim Kahler spoke in opposition to the Ordinance stating safety concerns with P59 and the high amount of traffic. Matt Alcazar, Steve Keigher and Lanny Jordison spoke in favor of the Ordinance stating that there currently is an Ordinance in place already allowing access to county gravel roads and limited access to county paved roads.

Discussion was held to change the current ordinance as follows: Exempt road through Brushy Creek State Recreation Area; Limit Access to County Blacktop P59 to Side Shoulders from Highway 20 north to the City Limits and Change End of Day time from 9:00 pm to Sunset.
