

**BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S Regular Meeting**

The Board of Supervisors met in Session on the above date with the following members present: Leffler, Campbell, Dencklau, Carlson and Thode. Absent: Thode

Moved by Dencklau, seconded by Leffler to remove item #6 Accept and place on file the resignation of Kathrine Anderson, Registered Nurse, Webster County Health Department, effective June 5, 2018 and approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Carlson to approve the May 22, 2018 meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Carlson, seconded by Dencklau to approve request from Ernest Kersten representing Eric Dillon requesting county held tax sale certificate (P160005-Parcel #0522430006) 510 Center St. Barnum, IA 50518 be assigned to him, offering to pay \$50.00 for this parcel. He will be responsible for the costs associated with serving the notice of expiration of ninety-day redemption period for the certificate. If Mr. Dillon receives and files of record with the Webster County Recorder a tax deed for the parcel, he asks the Board of Supervisors to cancel all delinquent taxes, interests and costs against each parcel. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Carlson, seconded by Dencklau to approve and authorize Chair to sign Fiscal Year 2019 Roadway Maintenance Agreement with Iowa Department of Transportation for roads within Brushy Creek State Park as requested by authorized Department of Natural Resources personnel. (Copy on file in Engineer's office) Motion carried unanimously.

Dennis Jones, Coleman District, stated privacy concerns with the Vanguard Appraisal Team that will be coming out to determine home valuations for tax purposes. Webster County Attorney Darren D. Driscoll stated Photos of the Appraisers and their Vehicle descriptions have been published, posted on our Website and several Facebook accounts as well. Homeowners are not required to allow the appraisal teams inside, however; the appraisers will then have to guess at what is inside and that could possibly raise the assessed value of their property.
