REMOVING STOP AND STOP AHEAD SIGNS FOR NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC ON KANSAS AVENUE APPROACHING 320<sup>TH</sup> STREET

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under the authority of Sections 321.236 and 321.255 and 321.345 of the Code of Iowa to designate any intersection as a stop intersection and to erect the signs at one or more entrances to such intersection, and

WHEREAS, the four way intersection at the junction of Kansas Avenue and 320<sup>th</sup> Street common to Sections 22, 23, 26 and 27, T-87N, R-29W, Clay Township, is controlled with stop and stop ahead signs for northbound traffic on Kansas Avenue approaching 320<sup>th</sup> Street, and

WHEREAS, the entire building site and vegetation at the southeast corner of the said intersection has been removed and returned to crop ground, and

WHEREAS, traffic would now be better served if the stop and stop ahead signs for northbound traffic on Kansas Avenue approaching 320<sup>th</sup> Street were removed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Webster County Board of Supervisors that the existing stop and stop ahead signs for northbound traffic on Kansas Avenue approaching 320<sup>th</sup> Street be removed;

This resolution shall be in effect when the traffic control signs are removed.

INSTALLING STOP AND STOP AHEAD SIGNS FOR NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC ON CARTER AVENUE APPROACHING 300<sup>TH</sup> STREET

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under the authority of Sections 321.236 and 321.255 and 321.345 of the Code of Iowa to designate any intersection as a stop intersection and to erect the signs at one or more entrances to such intersection, and

WHEREAS, the four way intersection at the junction of Carter Avenue and 300<sup>th</sup> Street common to Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, T-87N, R-30W, Roland Township, is currently uncontrolled by any traffic control devices other than the E911 intersection signs, and

WHEREAS, present traffic would be better served if the north and south approaches on Carter Avenue were made stop approaches to the intersection due to terrain, vegetation, and development, which limit sight distance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Webster County Board of Supervisors that stop and stop ahead signs be erected for northbound and southbound traffic on Carter Avenue approaching 300<sup>th</sup> Street;

This resolution shall be in effect when the traffic control signs are erected.
