The Board of Supervisors met in session on the above date with the following members present: Campbell, Carlson, Thode, Thode and Conrad Absent: Carlson

Moved by Campbell, seconded by Hayek to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Hayek, seconded by Thode to approve May 23, 2023, meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Thode, seconded by Campbell to approve the Consent Agenda:
