

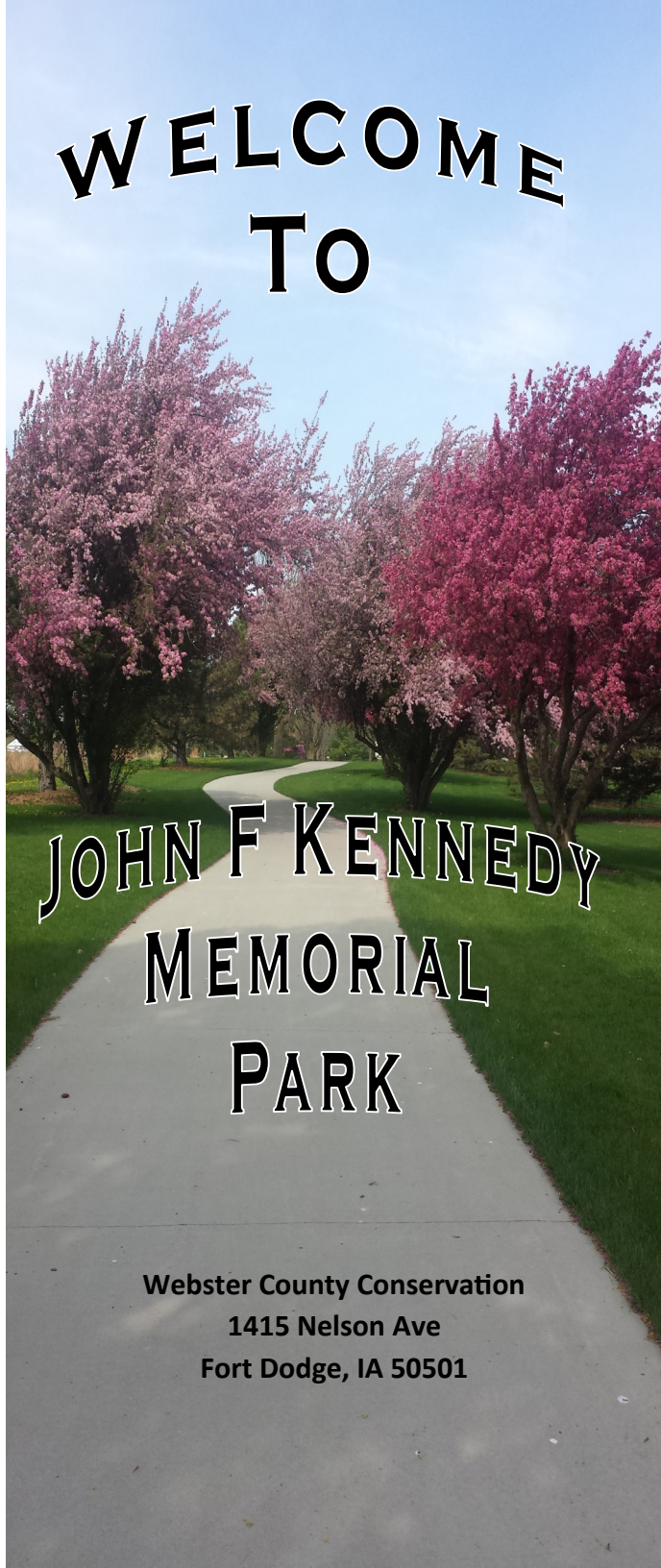


John F. Kennedy Memorial Park is a popular year-round destination and the headquarters of the Webster County Conservation Board. Construction of Kennedy Park began in 1962 and the park was officially dedicated in 1965.

The park is a 400 acre multi-use facility that offers something for everyone. Whether you have an entire weekend or just a few hours, you will find fun and excitement for the whole family. The 53-acre Badger Lake provides the focal point for a wide variety of outdoor activities including camping, fishing, picnicking, hiking, canoeing and boating (no gas motors) as well as the 18 hole Lakeside Municipal Golf Course.

FACILITIES & RENTALS

Bob Heun Shelter House

Available for rent on a reservation basis for graduation parties, family reunions, weddings & seasonal parties. The shelter can hold up to 150 people and is equipped with a refrigerator, sink, microwave, air conditioning, heat, bathrooms, tables & chairs.



Kennedy Park Yurts



These yurts provide for a fun overnight alternative for families who don't own a motorhome or don't like the hassle of tent camping. These dome-style cabins are managed as a 3-season cabin that are open to the public for use from April 15 through October 15 and are available by advance reservation only.

Veteran's Memorial Amphitheater & Shelter

The Veteran's Memorial Amphitheater and shelter may be reserved between April 1st and October 31st each year. The available hours are 8:00 am - 10:00 pm daily.



CAMPGROUND

The Kennedy Park Campground offers large, shaded sites for all types of camping - from the weekend tent camper to the full-time camper. The park offers the camping enthusiast one of the finest camping facilities around with 75 sites :

- 29 full hook-up
- 34 electric
- 8 primitive
- 4 seasonal

The campground contains modern restrooms and shower facilities that are cleaned daily. All campsites are available on a first come, first served basis
