

Fort Stevens Pedestrian Improvements

Project Location:

North side of 100th Way Southeast and along the west side of Grove Road Southeast.

Project Overview:

Students will have a much safer walk to school following the construction of 5-foot sidewalks, and newly painted crosswalks to better connect dozens of residential houses to Fort Stevens Elementary.

More than 950 feet of sidewalk was laid to improve safety for students and pedestrians along the north side of 100th Way Southeast and along the west side of Grove Road Southeast. The project also added ADA compliant access facilities, construction of 1,970 feet of curb, and created storm water systems.

The project began in March and construction was completed April, just over two weeks ahead of schedule. The City will be back in the fall to plant trees in the right of ways to keep our long-standing commitment to beautifying our city and maintaining our urban forest.

This is a federally funded project. The total project cost, including environmental surveys, engineering design and construction was \$794,600. Construction was funded by combination of grants from the Transportation Alternatives Program, Surface Transportation Program, and the Federal Highway Administration.
