This notice has been provided to appropriate local and state agencies, and property owners within 300 feet of the project site. This project will require a public hearing with the Yelm Hearing Examiner, who will render a written decision based on findings of fact. Property owners within 300 feet of the project site will be mailed a notice with the details of the public hearing once it has been scheduled. The Hearing Examiner decision may be appealed to the City Council within 21 days after the date the notice of decision is issued. Additionally, there will be a 14-day public comment period if an environmental determination is issued.
