**RESOLUTION NO.** 2021-012

**WHEREAS**, California Government Code section 8630 and Yuba County Ordinance Code section 4.20 empowers the Yuba County Board of Supervisors, or an official designated by ordinance, to proclaim the existence of a local emergency upon the existence of conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the County of Yuba (“County”); and

**WHEREAS**, on September 9, 2020, the County Director of Emergency Services (“Director”) proclaimed a local emergency pursuant to the powers prescribed under County Ordinance Code section 4.20.70(b)(1). Said local emergency arose by the sudden outbreak of a wildland fire in the County’s foothills, which caused the evacuation of a large portion of Loma Rica and destroyed approximately seven (7) homes (“Willow Fire”); and

**WHEREAS**, on September 16, 2020 the Board of Supervisors ratified the Director’s proclamation by way of Resolution No. 2020-119; and
