**2023-2024 COMPREHENSIVE INSPECTION, PENAL CODE SECTION 6031, WELFARE & INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTION 209, YUBA COUNTY DETENTION FACILITY**

Dear Sheriff Anderson:

The 2023-2024 Comprehensive Inspection of the Yuba County Sheriff's Office has been completed. A pre-inspection briefing was held on Wednesday, March 8, 2023, and the following facility was inspected on Tuesday, May 2, 2023:

This inspection was conducted pursuant to Penal Code Section 6031 to determine compliance with the Minimum Standards for Local Detention Facilities as outlined in Titles 15 and 24, California Code of Regulations. In addition, Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) staff conducted compliance monitoring pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Section 209(f) and the federal Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act (JJDP A).

In addition to the annual inspection by the BSCC, inspections are also required annually by the County Health Officer and biennially by the State Fire Marshal or an authorized representative (Health and Safety Code Sections 101045 and 13146.1). The results of those inspections are considered a part of this report. The Environmental Health inspection and the Nutritional inspection were performed on March 16, 2023. The Medical/Mental Health inspection is to be conducted later this year. The Yuba County Health and Human Services Department only issues a completed health inspection cover sheet upon completion of all inspections. All inspections were up to date as of December 31, 2022.

**INSPECTION RESULTS**

We identified no items of noncompliance with Title 15 Minimum Standards. Refer to the attached Title 15 Procedures Checklist for detailed information.

No items of noncompliance were identified with Title 24 Minimum Standards. Refer to the Physical Plant Evaluation (PHY) and Living Area Space Evaluation (LASE) attachments for information related to Rated Capacity.

**Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act Compliance Monitoring**

We found no violations of the JJDP A; a copy of the monitoring report is attached for your information.

An Exit Briefing with your staff was held on Tuesday, May 2, 2023; BSCC staff presented an inspection overview and discussed technical assistance and best practice recommendations.
