UNMET TRANSIT NEEDS IN YUBA COUNTY AND )  
AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF TRANSPORTATION )  
CLAIM FOR FUNDS FROM THE TRANSPORTATION )  
DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1971 AS AMENDED )**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2023-028**

**WHEREAS**, Section 99260 of the Public Utilities Code requires a local agency to file an estimated claim of transportation need for each fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (“SACOG”) is the designated Transportation Planning Agency for the County of Yuba to receive and consider such claims for approval pursuant to rules and regulations adopted by the Secretary of the California Business, Transportation, and Housing Agency; and

**WHEREAS**, SACOG has advised Yuba County of an apportionment for Fiscal Year 2022/2023 of \$2,363,837; this total amount includes the sum required for Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority transit needs in the amount of \$1,115,870; and

**WHEREAS**, SACOG has determined that there are no areas within Yuba County with unmet transit needs which can be reasonably met either through expansion of existing transportation systems or by establishing new systems, and this determination was made during SACOG’s noticed public hearing for Fiscal Year 2022/23; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds to meet the requirements of Fiscal Year 2022/2023 of the Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority can be met from the sum of \$1,115,870, the sum of \$1,177,052 can be utilized for street and road purposes, and the remaining sum of \$70,915 will be available for SACOG Planning Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Yuba intends to submit a Transportation Claim to the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) for funds available from the Transportation Development Act of 1971, as amended.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba hereby finds and declares that there are no areas within its jurisdiction with unmet transit needs which can reasonably be met either through expansion of existing transportation systems or by establishing new systems;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes submission of an Annual Transportation Claim to the Sacramento Area Council of Governments for \$2,363,837; such funds to be used for purposes indicated in claim with \$1,115,870 apportioned to Yuba-Sutter Transit Authority, \$1,177,052 for street and road purposes, and \$70,915 to SACOG for the Planning Program.






