**WHEREAS,** Recent legislation requires CalOES' California 9-1-1 Emergency Communications Branch to manage the State Emergency Telephone Number Account (SETNA) which provides reimbursement to Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs) for equipment and services necessary for the delivery and answering of 9-1-1 calls throughout the State. The goal is to enable each PSAP to provide the fastest, most reliable, and cost-effective access to emergency services for any 9-1-1 caller from any communication device throughout the State; and

**WHEREAS,** the Sheriff's Department's Dispatch/Records division operates as the Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) for Yuba County and operates with equipment that is near end of life and in need of replacement; and


**WHEREAS,** in order to preserve the integrity of call processing, as well as meet the evolution of new technologies and interoperability, the Department submitted an application for funding through the Customer Premise Equipment (CPE) Funding Opportunity through CalOES for new equipment and payment of the first five years of network service charges; and


**WHEREAS,** the County's Contract and Purchasing Policies Manual states that emergency purchases can be made when unforeseen circumstances require an immediate purchase in order to avoid a substantial hazard to life, property, or serious interruption of the operation of a County department.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby ratifies the application for CPE Funding for upgraded PSAP equipment and payment of the first five years of network service charges, and authorizes the Sheriff, or his designee, to execute subsequent forms, and any additional documentation necessary for the replacement of public safety equipment to support Department daily operations, subject to approval by County Counsel.
