RESOLUTION NO. 2023-087

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is responsible for the management of the public lands and resources and their various values so that they are considered in a combination that will best serve the needs of the American people; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the strong public need for a nationwide system of parks and other recreational and public purposes areas, the Congress, in 1954, enacted the Recreation and Public Purpose Act (68 Statute 173; 43 United States Code 869 et. seq.), revised August 1996, administered by the BLM; and

WHEREAS, under said act, any State, State agency, or political subdivision of a state may patent (purchase) or lease public lands administered by the BLM at no cost if for the purpose of public recreation; and

WHEREAS, the filing of an application with the BLM to purchase or lease public lands requires a resolution of the applicant authorizing such filing and execution; and

WHEREAS, Yuba County's current lease agreement for Hammon Grove with the BLM is set to expire in 2024 and will need to be extended by a letter of request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby:

1. Authorizes the filing of the application for land patent and lease of Hammon Grove with the Bureau of Land Management; and
2. Authorizes the submission of the lease extension request letter for Hammon Grove with the Bureau of Land Management; and
3. Authorizes the filing of the application for land lease of The Goldfields with the Bureau of Land Management; and
4. Authorizes the chair to execute said applications and letter; and
5. Certifies that the applicant, Yuba County, obligates themselves to the commitments, terms, and conditions as spelled out in the Recreation and Public Purpose Act as they relate to these applications.


