RESOLUTION NO: 2023-097

WHEREAS, the State Department of Water Resources is offering grant funds not to exceed \$125,000 to assist counties to prepare a drought and water shortage emergency response and long-term mitigation plan for domestic and small water suppliers; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development and Services Agency proposes to prepare a County Drought Resilience Plan pursuant to the requirements of Senate Bill (SC) 552 of 2021; and

WHEREAS, the County Drought Resilience Plan is being prepared in response to a Drought Scenario, as defined by Water Code section 13198(a), and is intended to address potential or immediate impacts on human health and safety for persons or communities that lose or are threatened with the loss or contamination of water supplies; and

WHEREAS, the County of Yuba Board of Supervisors ("Board") desires to delegate authority to the Community Development and Services Agency to enter a funding agreement with the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to delegate authority to the Community Development and Services Agency, Environmental Health Director, or Designee, to execute any future amendments to the funding agreement with the State Department of Water Resources, County Drought Resilience Planning Assistance Program so long as the amount does not exceed \$125,000 cumulatively and there are no significant changes in the program; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to delegate authority to the Environmental Health Director, or Designee, to make and sign all required certifications and to submit any required documents, invoices, and reports required to obtain grant funding; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Yuba County Board of Supervisors authorizes that pursuant and subject to all terms and provisions of the Budget Act of 2021, as amended (Stats. 2022, ch. 44 § 25). The Director of Environmental Health, or Designee, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and file an application for funding with the Department of Water Resources, and take such other actions as necessary or appropriate to obtain grant funding; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of Environmental Health, or Designee, is hereby authorized and directed to make and sign all required certifications and to submit any required documents, invoices and reports required to obtain funding and is hereby directed to execute the funding agreement and amendments as described herein with the Department of Water Resources; and

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BE IT FURTHER, that this Resolution is effective until rescinded by the Signature Authority and/or this governing body.


