Section R315.2.2 of the 2022 California Residential Code, Title 24 Part 2.5:

*"Where an addition is made to an existing dwelling, or a fuel-burning heater, appliance or fireplace is added to an existing dwelling, not previously required to be provided with carbon monoxide alarms, new carbon monoxide alarms shall be installed in accordance with Section R315."*

Carbon monoxide alarms shall be installed in the following locations:

1. Outside of each separate dwelling unit sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms.
2. On every level of a dwelling unit including basement.
3. Where a fuel-burning appliance is located within a bedroom or its attached bathroom, a carbon monoxide alarm shall be installed within the bedroom.

**Combination alarms:** Combination carbon monoxide alarms and smoke alarms shall comply with Section R315 and all requirements for listing and approval by the Office of the State Fire Marshall for smoke alarms.

**Power Source:** In dwelling units where there is no commercial power supply, the carbon monoxide alarm(s) may be solely battery operated as per R315.5 (exceptions.)

As owner of the above-referenced property, I hereby certify that carbon monoxide and smoke alarm(s) have been installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and in compliance with section R315 of the 2022 California Building Code, Title 24 Part 2.5.
