RESOLUTION NO. 2022-256

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors made a finding of public purpose and approved the creation of a Business Façade Grant Program in August, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the intent of this program is to enhance the aesthetic appeal of the corridor and improve business performance through external property improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the Board approved the allocation of \$500,000 from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding, allowing property owners or tenants to receive up to \$15,000 per business for eligible reimbursements; and,

WHEREAS, the program has been met with positive interest within the target area, however remaining capacity exists in the allocated budget; and,

WHEREAS, two adjacent commercial corridors exist to the west and east, Feather River Boulevard to Alicia Avenue and North Beale Road to Hammonton Smartsville, respectively; and,

WHEREAS, the intent of the Business Façade Grant Program may benefit economic development, enhance business performance and prevent urban decay in this expanded service area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba hereby:

1. Authorize the Business Façade Grant Program to expand the service area to the adjacent commercial corridors, within the boundaries of the aforementioned intersections.


