WHEREAS, on January 10, 2017, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to California Government Code section 8630 and Yuba County Ordinance Code chapter 4.20, proclaimed a local emergency due to floodwaters (Resolution No. 2017-02); and

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 8630(c), requires the Board of Supervisors to review, at least every sixty (60) days, the need for continuing the local emergency until the termination of such emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors does hereby find that the factual findings made in Resolution No. 2017-02 continue to exist, and local resources remain insufficient to cope with the effects of said emergency and require the assistance of other political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors hereby continues the local emergency due to the ongoing needs of the public in the aftermath of the flood waters; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code section 8630(d), the Board of Supervisors shall terminate the local emergency as soon as reasonably possible.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Yuba County Board of Supervisors does hereby continue the January 10, 2017, Proclamation of a Local Emergency in Yuba County, as a result of the floodwaters that has caused damage to public and private property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors shall review, at least every sixty (60) days, until such emergency is terminated, the need for the continuing said emergency and shall proclaim the termination of the local emergency at the earliest possible date.




