RESOLUTION NO. 2020-138

WHEREAS, the California Department of Social Services ("CDSS") has made funds available to implement or expand a local Housing and Disability Income Advocacy Program ("HDAP"); and

WHEREAS, the HDAP is a county administered program, established under Assembly Bill (AB) 1603 (Chapter 25, Statutes of 2016), that assists disabled individuals who are experiencing homelessness apply for disability benefit programs while also providing housing assistance; and

WHEREAS, the CDSS will allocate funds for the HDAP on a competitive basis for the purposes of implementing the Housing and Disability Advocacy Program (HDAP); and

WHEREAS, counties must submit a certification and request HDAP funds in an amount greater than or less than the county's need, as determined and allocated by the CDSS. Said application and/or certification may include a program proposal and program budget approved, or pending approval, by the applicant county's Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, counties receiving state HDAP funds are required to match the state funding on a dollar-for-dollar basis; and

WHEREAS, the CDSS has allocated \$458,127.00 in additional funds to the County of Yuba ("County") for fiscal years 2017-2021; and

WHEREAS, the County Director of the Health and Human Services Department ("Director") seeks to apply for and be allocated HDAP funds; and

WHEREAS, the Director shall, at the earliest possible date, and if applicable, obtain approval of the HDAP program proposal and program budget from the Board of Supervisors at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of the Health and Human Services Department to submit a certification for the HDAP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors that the Director of the Health and Human Services Department is hereby authorized to: execute, subject to review and approval of County Counsel, all documents as required by the certification and the resultant allocation for the stated three year period; to execute agreements, memorandums of understanding (MOUs) or amendments developed under HDAP, including but not limited to amendments for additional or lesser funding; and to accept, transfer and allocate all HDAP funds for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2023. A copy of the executed agreement, MOU or any amendment thereto shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Board.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors that the Director of the Health and Human Services Department shall, at the earliest possible date, return to the Board of Supervisors to obtain approval of the final HDAP program proposal and program budget to be submitted, or already submitted, to the California Department of Social Services.


