**RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION)
2020-23 WHICH RATIFIED THE)
EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL HEALTH)
EMERGENCY) RESOLUTION NO. 2021-063**

WHEREAS, Section 101080 of the California Health and Safety Code authorizes a local health officer to declare a local health emergency within the health officer's jurisdiction, or any part thereof, whenever the health officer reasonably determines that there is an imminent and proximate threat of the introduction of any contagious, infectious, or communicable disease, chemical agent, non-communicable biologic agent, toxin, or radioactive agent; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020 Governor Gavin Newsom declared a statewide emergency as a result of the global pandemic caused by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Yuba Sutter Public Health Officer declared a local health emergency on March 10, 2020 as a result of the global pandemic caused by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, also on March 10, 2020 the Board adopted resolution 2020-23 ratifying the declaration of a local health emergency throughout Yuba County pursuant to California Health and Safety Code 101080; and

WHEREAS, since that time great progress has been made in reducing the spread of COVID-19 including the development of treatment regimens and vaccines to protect against infection; and

WHEREAS, as of today's date, all local health orders issued within Yuba County by the Yuba Sutter Public Health Officer have been rescinded; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has issued Executive Orders and the California Department of Public Health has issued Public Health Orders including the "Blueprint for a Safer Economy" to permit gradual reopening of certain businesses and activities which remain in force and effect throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, in consultation with the Yuba Sutter Public Health Officer it has been determined that there is no longer a need to continue the local health emergency declared and ratified on March 10, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code section 101080 provides that the Board of Supervisors shall proclaim the termination of the local health emergency at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant termination.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby determine and order that the local health emergency currently in effect is no longer necessary, the Board therefore rescinds Resolution 2020-23 and proclaims the termination of the local health emergency.




