WHEREAS, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (“Department” or “HCD”) has issued a Notice of Funding Availability (“NOFA”) for the Community Development Block Grant Program (“CDBG”), made available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”), pursuant to the January 2021 funding year. The federal Small Cities CDBG program is authorized by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (“HCDA”) as amended and codified at Title 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) §5301 et. seq., and Subpart 1 of the Federal CDBG Regulations, found at Title 24 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §570.480. The requirements of the State of California CDBG Program are in California Health and Safety Code (HSC) §§50825-50834; and

WHEREAS, a Resolution authorizing an application, to the California State Department of Housing and Community Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), pursuant to the January 2021 CDBG Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA); and

WHEREAS, the County of Yuba, a political subdivision of the State of California, wishes to submit to the State of California of one or more application(s) in the aggregate amount, not to exceed, \$750,000, as described in APPENDIX D attached hereto and made a part of herein, for the following CDBG activities, pursuant to the January 2021 CDBG NOFA; and

Planning Study– Homelessness, not to exceed	<u>\$250,000.00</u>
Planning Study - Economic Development, not to exceed	<u>\$250,000.00</u>
Planning Study – Sidewalks/Curbs/Gutters, not to exceed	<u>\$250,000.00</u>

WHEREAS, the County will use Program Income in an amount not to exceed \$ zero dollars for the CDBG activities described in Section 3; and

WHEREAS, the County acknowledges compliance with all state and federal public participation requirement in the development of its application(s); and

WHEREAS, the County hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee, to execute and deliver all applications and act on the County’s behalf in all matters pertaining to all such applications; and

WHEREAS, that if an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee, is authorized to enter into, execute and deliver the grant agreement (i.e., Standard Agreement) and any and all subsequent amendments thereto with the State of California for the purposes of the grant; and

WHEREAS, that if an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee, is authorized to sign and submit Funds Request and all required reporting forms and other documentation as may be required by the State of California from time to time in connection with the Agreement for purposes of the Grant; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby declare:

Section 1. That the above recitals are all true and correct.

Section 2. That the County Board of Supervisors hereby approves a Resolution authorizing the submission of an application, to the California State Department of Housing and Community Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG), pursuant to the January 2021 CDBG NOFA; and

Section 3. That the County Board of Supervisors has reviewed and hereby approves the submission to the State of California of one or more application(s) in the aggregate amount, not to exceed, \$750,000 the following CDBG activities, pursuant to the January 2021 CDBG Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA); and

Planning Study –Homelessness, not to exceed	<u>\$250,000.00</u>
Planning Study - Economic Development, not to exceed	<u>\$250,000.00</u>
Planning Study –Sidewalks/Curbs/Gutters, not to exceed	<u>\$250,000.00</u>

Section 4. That the County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the use of Program Income in an amount not to exceed \$ Zero Dollars for the CDBG activities described in Section 3; and

Section 5. That the County Board of Supervisors acknowledges compliance with all state and federal public participation requirements in the development of its application(s); and

Section 6. The County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee, to execute and deliver all applications and act on the County’s behalf in all matters pertaining to all such applications; and

Section 7. That if an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee, is authorized to enter into, execute and deliver the grant agreement (i.e., Standard Agreement) and any and all subsequent amendments thereto with the State of California for the purposes of the grant; and

Section 8. That if an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee, is authorized to sign and submit Funds Requests and all required reporting forms and other documentation as may be required by the State of California from time to time in connection with the grant; and

Section 9. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.



RESOLUTION NO. 2021-073

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING AND THE EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO FROM THE 2020-2021 FUNDING YEAR OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba as follows:

SECTION 1:

The County Board of Supervisors has reviewed and hereby approves the submission to the State of California of one or more application(s) in the aggregate amount, not to exceed, of \$ 750,000.00 for the following CDBG activities, pursuant to the January 2021 CDBG NOFA:

Planning Study-Homelessness, not to exceed	\$ <u>250,000.00</u>
Planning Study-Economic Development, not to exceed	\$ <u>250,000.00</u>
Planning Study- Sidewalks/Curbs/Gutters, not to exceed	\$ <u>250,000.00</u>

SECTION 2:

The County hereby approves the use of Program Income in an amount not to exceed \$zero dollars for the CDBG activities described in Section 1.

SECTION 3:

The County acknowledges compliance with all state and federal public participation requirements in the development of its application(s).

SECTION 4:

The County hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee*, to execute and deliver all applications and act on the County's behalf in all matters pertaining to all such applications.



APPENDIX D

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SECTION 5:

If an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee*, is authorized to enter into, execute and deliver the grant agreement (*i.e.*, Standard Agreement) and any and all subsequent amendments thereto with the State of California for the purposes of the grant.

SECTION 6:

If an application is approved, the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or designee, is authorized to sign and submit Funds Requests and all required reporting forms and other documentation as may be required by the State of California from time to time in connection with the grant.

** **Important Note:** If the designee is signing any application, agreement, or any other document on behalf of the designated official of the City/County, written proof of designee authority to sign on behalf of such designated official must be included with the Resolution, otherwise the Resolution will be deemed deficient and rejected. Additionally, do not add limitations or conditions on the ability of the signatory or signatories to sign documents, or the Resolution may not be accepted. If more than one party's approval is required, list them as a signatory. The only exception is for county counsel or city attorney to approve as to form or legality or both, IF such approval is already part of the standard city/county signature block as evidenced by the signed Resolution itself. Inclusions of additional limitations or conditions on the authority of the signer will result in the Resolution being rejected and will require your entity to issue a corrected Resolution prior to the Department issuing a Standard Agreement.*
