RESOLUTION NO. 2021-114

WHEREAS, the Yuba County Service Authority was formed in 1991 creating the Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Program (“AVA”) for the abatement of abandoned vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the AVA program (“AVA”) over the prior ten-year operational period (2012-2022) has contributed more than \$295,000.00 and allowed for the removal of more than 700 nuisance vehicles from the County of Yuba; and

WHEREAS, the AVA program is set to expire in April 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to the County of Yuba to have the Program continue.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Board of Supervisors does hereby extend the County of Yuba's participation in the Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Program until April 30, 2032.


