RESOLUTION NO. 2021-122

WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by Article 1, Section 2 of the U.S. Constitution to conduct an accurate count of the population every ten years; and

WHEREAS, Census data is used to determine federal funding levels and congressional representation, both of which are critical to state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2019, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors adopted a resolution in support of and partnership with the State for the 2020 Census; and

WHEREAS, the County of Yuba, in partnership with Yuba-Sutter Economic Development Corporation, other local governments, businesses and community organizations; and along with the region and the state committed to ensuring an accurate count of residents; and

WHEREAS, every ten years following the Census, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors must redraw the supervisorial district boundaries, ensuring that these boundaries have substantially equal populations and comply with the Voting Rights Act of 1965 and new redistricting legislations; and

WHEREAS, the County of Yuba provides Informational Technology (IT) services including Geographic Information System (GIS) mapping services billed at the IT fee schedule as part of the Master Fee Schedule as posted; and

WHEREAS, a significant amount of work is required in order to achieve a compliant and successful 2021 Redistricting; and

WHEREAS, recognizing these challenges, the County of Yuba wishes to offer GIS mapping services to Yuba County local jurisdictions requesting for such services related to the 2021 Redistricting; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of efficient and effective county government for the Board of Supervisors to authorize the County Administrator or his/her designee to execute Memoranda of Understanding on behalf of Yuba County.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Yuba County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Yuba County Administrator or his/her designee to enter into Memoranda of Understanding and any additional future amendments related as set forth by legislation in connection to the 2021 Redistricting with Yuba County local jurisdictions for 2021 Redistricting associated to GIS mapping services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any Memorandum of Understanding entered into by the County Administrator or his/her designee must ensure that the agency fully reimburse the County for the cost of the services provided to the outside local agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any Memorandum of Understanding provide for the defense and indemnification of the County against and from any claims, suits, losses, actions, damages, lawsuits, and liabilities arising from or connected with the services provided.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any Memorandum of Understanding entered into pursuant to this resolution be approved by County Counsel and the Risk Manager.
