WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the County of Yuba to implement mitigation projects prior to a disaster event, thereby reducing overall risks to the population and structures, while also reducing reliance on funding from actual disaster declarations; and

WHEREAS, your Board of Supervisors adopted the Yuba County Multi-Jurisdictional, Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan and jurisdictional annexes in accordance with the FEMA Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act in September 2007; and

WHEREAS, The Yuba County Board of Supervisors accepted and adopted the updates Mitigation Plan on October 26, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plans are required to be reviewed and updated no less than every five years to maintain jurisdictional eligibility for state and federal mitigation funds.


