WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the County of Yuba that the County have in place a comprehensive, all-hazard emergency preparedness system for the protection of life and property as they relate to emergency management capabilities, including, among other things, protection against threats of terrorism, evacuation planning, disaster financial management, catastrophic disasters and other emerging threats; and

WHEREAS, it is further in the interest of the citizens of the County of Yuba to obtain federal financial assistance provided by the Federal Department of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the State of California to accomplish such goals; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Management Performance Grant-American Rescue Plan Act (“EMPG-ARPA”) supports the implementation of State Homeland Security Strategies to address the identified planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise needs to prevent,

protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from the aforementioned emergencies, acts of terrorism and other catastrophic events; and

WHEREAS, the Yuba County Office of Emergency Services seeks to apply for available grant funds under the EMPG-ARPA for Fiscal Year 2021 for the Operational Area allocation of \$60,594.00 in order to support the County of Yuba’s all-hazard emergency preparedness system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors, that the Emergency Operations Manager OR Emergency Operations Planner is hereby authorized to apply for the EMPG-ARPA for Fiscal Year 2021 on behalf of the County of Yuba for the Operational Area allocation of \$60,594.00, including execute all documents, subject to County Counsel approval, required by the EMPG-ARPA.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, in the event the EMPG is awarded to the County of Yuba, the Emergency Operations Manager or Office of Emergency Services Planner is hereby

authorized to accept, transfer, and allocate grant funds in accordance with the terms of the EMPG-ARPA in an amount not to exceed \$60,594.00.


