**WHEREAS**, the County of Yuba owns an emergency temporary shelter facility commonly known as “14Forward” and located at 938 14<sup>th</sup> Street in Marysville, California; and

**WHEREAS**, in June of 2016, 14Forward was operationalized to address the immediate need for shelter among persons experiencing homelessness in Yuba County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Health and Human Services Department (HHSD) operated the facility from the summer of 2016 until the fall of 2019, with support from several other County departments, including Community Development and Services Agency, County Counsel, Administrative Services, and the County Administrator’s Office; and

**WHEREAS**, to reduce the administrative burden, the County sought to contract with a community partner who specialized in homeless shelter provision, to operate and maintain 14Forward; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 22, 2019, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors approved a Professional Services Agreement between the County of Yuba and The Salvation Army for the 14Forward operations effective November 1, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, at the time of its development, 14Forward was not intended to be a permanent facility, so efforts have begun to secure technical assistance to determine the details, including need, capacity, funding, and location, for the development of a shelter with a permanent foundation; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of the County to contract with a single agency to operate and maintain 14Forward – a temporary shelter facility – and to simultaneously work in collaboration with the County to develop a permanent shelter facility, so a Request for Proposal (“RFP”) was initiated for these two critical needs; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 28, 2021, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors approved the recommendation to award a contract with The Salvation Army as a result of the RFP to operate and maintain the County’s 14Forward temporary shelter facility and to work collaboratively with the County on all aspects of the development of a permanent shelter facility; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the interest of efficient and effective county government to have a Resolution of the Board of Supervisors authorizing the HHSD Director to enter into, execute and amend as needed, on behalf of the County of Yuba, the Professional Services Agreement for shelter services and the Site Access Agreement for site access to 14Forward, with The Salvation Army.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors that the HHSD Director is authorized to enter into, execute and amend as needed, on behalf of the County of Yuba and upon review and approval of County Counsel, the Agreement for Professional Services with The Salvation Army to operate and maintain the County’s 14Forward temporary shelter facility and to work collaboratively with the County on all aspects of the development of a permanent shelter facility, for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.

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**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors that the HHSD Director is authorized to enter into, execute and amend as needed, on behalf of the County of Yuba and upon review and approval of County Counsel, the Site Access Agreement with The Salvation Army to provide site access to the County's 14Forward temporary shelter facility, for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024.

A copy of the fully executed agreement or any amendment thereto shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Board, County of Yuba.


